5. Challenging Christians to understand the Jewish roots of our faith and God’s purposes for Israel, and to combat anti-Semitism in all its forms.

In addition to pointing Jewish people to Jesus as the Messiah, we also want to help Christians understand the Jewish roots of our faith. We "pray for the peace of Jerusalem" which includes her spiritual renewal as well as physical safety. Our desire is to demonstrate the love of Yeshua and whenever possible, to give evidence from the Scriptures of his Messiahship.
